MODIFICATION TO REPORTING EXTRA DUTIES STARTING WITH THE 2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

June 2024

Extra-Duty Reporting for 2023-24 and Prior Years

F-Full-time and P-part-time contractual

Extra duties that involve teaching or supervising students and other assignments related to the academic program are reportable as creditable earnings for full-time and part-time contractual members.

S-Substitute and H-part-time noncontractual

Extra duties performed by substitutes or part-time noncontractual members are not reportable unless the extra duty requires teacher licensure by law. Extra duties that require licensure are reportable regard-less of employment status (e.g., band director). For more information about extra-duty reporting, see *Employer Guide*, Chapter 3, Creditable Earnings.

E-Extra duty

Earnings for a member who is not employed as a regular teacher but who performs extra duties that do not require teacher licensure are reportable only if the member is employed as a full-time or part-time contractual member by another TRS-covered employer.

Extra-Duty Reporting for 2024-25 and Future Years

F-Full-time, P-part-time contractual, S-Substitute and H-part-time noncontractual

Extra duties that involve teaching or supervising students and other assignments related to the academic program are reportable as creditable earnings for full-time, part-time contractual, substitute and part-time noncontractual members, provided the member is employed during the school year with a TRS-covered employer in a position requiring licensure. Earnings reported to TRS is not limited to the primary employer.

E-Extra duty

Earnings for a member who is not employed as a regular teacher but who performs extra duties that do not require teacher licensure are reportable only if the member is employed as a full-time, part-time contractual, substitute or part-time noncontractual member by another TRS-covered employer.
